KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Mary L. Moon of R. F. D. # 6 Greenville Post Office, Greenville County

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars, to me in hand paid of and before the sealing of these presents by

George E. English of Shelby North Carolina (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said George E. English all that piece, parcel or tract of lands in Great Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina about two miles South of the City of Greenville on both sides of Beedy Fork Creek, branch waters of Beedy River, adjoining lands of John Davenport, J. M. Griffin, W. N. Lenderman, C. W. Washington, W. H. Ashmore, Mrs Betty Ashmore (estate of James O. Ashmore) and John D. Harris, known as the Ashmore Mill Place, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a pine on the east side of the new cut Augustal road, Mrs H. Ashmore, Betty Ashmore and Mary L. Moon's corner and running thence S 50 1/2 N. 18 1/2 chains to a stone Harris's, Betty Ashmore's and Mary L. Moon's corner; thence S 22 1/2 E along J. D. Harris' land 2.20 chains to a pine stump on the North bank of Beedy Fork Creek Harris' and Mrs Moon's corner; thence S 27 E (crossing the Creek) 1.16 chains to a stone, Harris's, Davenport's and Mrs Moon's corner; thence S 41 1/2 E 16.15 chains to a stone, Davenport's, Griffin's and Mrs Moon's corner; thence following Griffin's and Lenderman's land S 23 1/2 E 17.30 chains to a stake near a willow in the farmer bed of the creek (formerly a maple) Lenderman's and Mrs Moon's corner; thence along Lenderman's line across the bottom and creek S. 7 E 3.30 chains to a stone beside a post-oak sapling (formerly a spruce oak stump) near the east bank of the creek Lenderman's, Washington's and Mrs Moon's corner; thence along Washington's land N. 63 1/2 E 5.81 chains to a stone at foot of a Poplar on the West bank of a small branch; thence N 9 1/2 W 5.43 chains

to a stone; thence N. 44 W. 2.64 chains to a stone at the edge of the bottom; thence N. 6 W. 2.40 chains to a stone at edge of bottom (formerly a white oak); thence N. 42 W. II chains to a stone; thence N. 27 W. 2.20 chains to a stone, Washington's W. H. Ashmore's and Mrs Moon's corner; thence N. 4 1/2 W. 21.56 chains to the beginning; containing Forty-five and one half (45 1/2) acres, more or less according to a survey made November 8th, 1905 by G. L. Walker, being the same tract conveyed to the said Mary L. Moon, by Mary J. Harris on the twelfth day of March, 1889 as recorded in the office of the Register of Meane Conveyance for said County in book U. U. page 822.
