Knight, all that tract of land, being, being and situated in County and State aforesaid containing twenty-five acres, more or less, being part of a certain tract of land, conveyed to John M. Nabors, on the 16th day of March A.D. 1877 by Joseph P. Nabors, et al and recorded in Vol. 34, p. 36, gift of office of R.M.L. for said County on the 28 day of January 1903 and conveyed by deed to H. S. Nabors by J. M. Nabors on - day of August 1905 and bounded by bounds of Lucy Burton, H. S. Nabors and Haupton Gray and being further described as follows: Beginning on stone at foot of coal road and thence N. 2 E. 12.00 ft to stones on each side of road; thence N. 74 1/4 E. 14.00 to stones in field; thence S. 2 W. 2.50 to stones; thence N. 74 1/4 E. 8.25 to stones; thence S. 2 W. 10.00 to stones on Haupton Gray's line; thence S. 74 1/4 W. 22.80 to Beginning corner.
