L. Cannada and M. Estelle Cannada, their heirs and assigns forever, all that piece, parcel or tract of land, situate lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid, adjoining lands of Taylor Williams and others, on the east side of Enoree River, containing One Hundred acres, more or less and having the following boundary, to-wit: Beginning on an Old White Oak on or near a branch of Lick Creek; thence up said Creek to the fork; thence up South fork to a White Oak corner adjoining Harden Roberts line; thence with Harden Robert's line to a post Oak; thence to the beginning corner and being the same tract of land conveyed to Mark & Endel by R. A. D. Harden by deed dated November 4th., 1882, and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. N. N. page 361.

Estelle Cannada and their Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
