Nash, Ed Chapman, Will Coleman and Robert Thomason, as shown by plat made by J.W. Stewart Surveyed 1906

TOGETHER will all and singular the Rights, Members, Heraditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Samuel Stallings, and his Heirs and Assigns forever

And we do hereby bind ourselves & Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said Samuel Stallings and his

Heirs and Assigns, against us and our Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
