KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Henry Briggs, of the County of Greenville and in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Four hundred (\$400.00) and no/100 Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

Canton West (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Canton West, all that piece, parcel and lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, just out-side the Corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the North-west corner of the lot recently bought by the said Canton West, from the said Henry Briggs, and running S. 56-1/2 W. One hundred (100) feet to an iron pin; thence S. 33-1/2 E. Eighty-three (83) feet to an iron pin; thence N. 56-1/2 E. One hundred and fifty (150) feet to an iron pin; thence N. 33-1/2 W. twenty-two (22) feet to an iron pin, corner of said lot formerly bought by said West from said Briggs; thence S. 56-1/2 W. with line of said lot fifty (50) feet to the South-west corner of said lot; thence N. 33-1/2 W. with line of said lot Sixty-one (61) feet to the beginning corner, being a portion of the land conveyed to me by D.D. Bailey, by his deed bearing date the 10th, day of September 1907, which is recorded in the office of Register Meane Conveyance for Greenville County Book VVV page 534.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Canton West, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Canton West, his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
