Harris, all my undivided one-half interest in all that piece, parcel and tract of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid about two and one-half miles from the City of Greenville, having the following marks bearings distances to wit: Beginning at a stone in center of road and running thence S 73-3/4 W 33 links to a railroad iron, thence S 26-1/2 E 27.13 to a stone, thence N 42 E 13.00 to a stone, thence up center of road, N 28 W 8.00 to a bend in road, thence N 71-1/2 W. 6.93 to a bend in road, thence N 61 1/4 W. 11.50 to the beginning corner, and containing nineteen and eighty five one hundredths (19.85) acres, more or less, and joining lands of Mrs Charles and others

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
