Re: Building Renovation 105 East North Street Greenville, South Carolina

Gentlesen:

We offer for your consideration a Cost Plus Guaranteed Haximum proposal in the amount of THREE HUNDRED NINETY THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$393,000.00) to renovate referenced building as described below:

Scope of Work will be as follows:

A. Demolition

- 1. Remove existing stairs, elevator shaft and remaining partition walls from First and Second Floor levels.
- 2. Remove existing vinyl tile and raised wood flooring that interferes with new floor finish.
- 3. Remove four (K) window units from east elevation and two (2) window units from south elevation on Second Floor.

B. Structural

- 1. Install footings and steel to support Second Floor.
- 2. Remove steel rods from roof trusses supporting Second Floor.
- 3. Close floor openings over basement area.
- 4. Furnish and install beam and plate lintel at new door openings in existing walls.
- 5. Provide steel framing at roof opening.

C. Finishes

- 1. Walls Install 1" x 4" furring strip on masonry walls and finish with 1/2" sheet rock. Interior walls to be 2" x 4" wood study with 1/2" sheet rock both sides. Walls to be painted with two coats latex and 4" high vinyl base to be installed at base of all walls.
- Deilings Install 2'x 4' lay in type ceiling for the First and Second Floor, Second to receive 6" batt insulation above ceiling.
- Doors & Hardware Doors to be 1-3/4" solid core wood doors with wood jambs.
 Hardware to include 1-1/2 pair butts and lockset for each door. Doors
 and jambs to be stained.
- 4. Floors Floors to be rapired and leveled with gypcrete and finished carpet we have included an allowance of \$12.00 per square yard for approximately 966 square yards of carpet. Entrance foyer to be finished with quarry tile.
- 5. Glass & Glazing Install fixed glass in office areas as shown on First Floor layout.
