interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per centum besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collected as a part thereof if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, deeded to me by Olive A. Peace on  
June 15th, 1918 and recorded in Vol. - - page - - - on the southwest corner of Stone Ave.  
and Wilton St., 61 feet on Stone Ave, and by 150 feet on Wilton St., more or less; more  
fully described by plat of said office in plat book A., page 89.
