in the full and just sum of Eight hundred and two and 65/100 (\$852.65)

Dollars, to be paid one year after

with interest thereon from this date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose the mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

8 per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said W.G. Bishop, All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land,

situate, lying and being in Paris Mountain Township, County and State aforesaid about
nine miles North of Greenville City, on the Little Texas Road, adjoining lands of Mrs.
Mary Hill, Mrs. Texia A. Evans and others, containing twenty and sixty-nine one hundred-
ths (20-69/100) acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
Beginning at a stone on the Little Texas Road, and running thence N. 1/8 E. 11.00 to a stone
3X0M; thence N. 68-3/4 W. 8.00 to a stone; thence S. 25 W. 3.36 to stone; thence S. 2
E. 3.36 to stone NM; thence S. 33 W. 5.00 to stone NM; thence N. 63-1/4 W. 2.79 to a stone
OM Evans corner; thence S. 19-1/4 W. 14.50 to the Hillhouse Creek OM; thence up said Creek
N. 55-3/4 E. 3.82 to bend in said creek; thence with said Creek N. 62-1/4 E. 5.00 to bend
in said creek; thence N. 87-3/4 E. 1.00 to stone OM at ford of creek on Little Texas road;
thence N. 55-1/2 E. 6.38 to bend in road; thence N. 75 E. 5.25 to the beginning corner,
being the same tract of land conveyed to me by Elizabeth Brown by deed bearing date of Nov.
14th, 1918 and this mortgage to secure money borrowed for part of purchase price of same.
