interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10.00

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as with more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said W. C. Lindley all that certain

aforesaid, containing fifty-five and one half
(55 1/2) acres more or less and being more
particularly described as follows: Beginning
at iron on J. P. Slatens line and running thence
S 22 3/4 W. 23.93 to an iron pin x 3: thence N 87 1/4
W 2.13 to corner in branch by a poplin: thence
S. 15 E 3.80 to rock x 3: thence S 4 1/2 E 19.93 to
rock x 3: thence N. 4 3 1/2 E 14.07 to rock x 3: thence
