Dollars, to be paid as follows, Three Hundred Dollars Dec 31st 1919  
Three Hundred Dollars Dec. 31st 1920, Three Hundred  
Dollars Dec. 31st 1921, and Three Hundred Dollars Dec. 31st 1922  
with interest thereon from Date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid Annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference

on the South side of Moore Street and desig-  
nated as Lot #15 of survey made of Fannie M  
Fewlands by H. N. Willis, said lot having a  
frontage of Sixty (60) feet on Moore Street, and

three tenths (133.3) feet on East side of lot to  
alley.
