with interest thereon from the date of the date of the note at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent of amount due besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to

the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part hereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

land lying, being and situated in the State and County aforesaid and near the town of Fountain Inn, having the following metes and bounds: Commencing at an iron pin on corner of lot owned by Mrs. N.E. McDowell and running thence N. 84 E. 6.47 to corner of lot belonging to Mrs. S.C. Fulmer; thence S. 7-3/4 E. 4.28 to an iron pin; thence N. 86-1/4 E. 2.39 to corner of lot belonging to H.M. Stephens; thence S. 2 W. 16. 01 to corner of lands of Jno. R. Harrison; thence S. 85-1/4 W. 8.41 to corner of lands of Mrs. N.M. Armstrong (formerly owned by L.P.
