sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference

on south side of Tindall Avenue, and being known as lot #28 of Block B., of the property
of Cagle Park Company, a plat of which is recorded in the office of R.M.C. for Greenville
County in Plat Book C., at page 238 and being more particularly described as follows:
Beginning at a stake on south side of Tindal Avenue at corner of lot #27 and running thence
with line of lot #27 S. 0-53 E. 199.8 feet to point on line lot 18; thence with line of lots
