to-wit: All that parcel or lot of land situate in

South Carolina, on the South side of Webster Street
and having the following metes and bounds:
Beginning at an iron pin at a rock wall at the
corner of Nathan Hatcher's lot; thence running
east along said Webster Street fifty feet and eleven
inches to a fence; thence south along said fence
one hundred two feet and three inches to dividing
fence between lot belonging to Gandy Wooten,
bought from Butler and Mc Cullough; thence along
said fence fifty-one feet to a fence dividing the
property of Nathan Hatcher and this property; thence
north along said fence one hundred one feet and
six inches to the beginning corner, containing 5151,
square feet, more or less, being the same land
