WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Three thousand Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

All that lot of land situate on the North side of East Avenue at the intersection of McGee Street in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of East Avenue at the intersection of McGee Street and runs thence N. 21.45 W. one hundred and fifty-five feet to an iron pin on an alley; thence with said Alley S. 80 W. fifty one feet and eight inches to a pin; thence S. 21.45 E. one hundred and fifty-five feet to a pin on East Avenue; thence with East Avenue N. 80 E. fifty one feet and eight inches to the beginning corner, being a portion of lots 49, 50 and 51 as shown by plat recorded in Plat Book C., page 97 and being the same lot conveyed to me by Laura R. Jackson by deed dated the - - July 1918 and not yet recorded.
