WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Twelve Hundred (1200.00) Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land in the State and County aforesaid, in the City of Greenville, beginning at a stake near the Greenville and Columbia R.R.; about one mile from the Court House and running thence S. 9 1/2 N. 5.75 Chas. to a stake; thence N. 89 N. 1.42 Chs. to a stake; thence N. 9 1/2 E. 5.09 Chs. to a stake thence S. 67 E. 1.58 Chs. to the beginning corner, and being the same lot of land, conveyed to me by J. C. Mifford by deed recorded in the R. M. C. office for the County and State aforesaid in Vol. 13 page 346.
