WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of One Thousand

Dollars of money loaned this 4th day of March 1920 at the rate of Eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar association, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Mullard Street, in the City of Greenville, at a point 20 feet from the corner of Silas McPhee property, this point being the southeast corner of lot No. 1; thence with line of Mullard Street S. 21.44 W. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 46.21 W. 176.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 18.39 E. 59.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 76.21 W. 179.6 feet to the beginning corner, being the land conveyed to me by Virginia B. Sossaman, the 15th day of March 1918 recorded in Vol. 51 page 95.
