WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of One thousand five hundred Dollars, which they loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of six per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

That lot of land in the City of Greenville, said County and State, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a point, Lula Thompson's corner of Green Avenue and running thence with Green Avenue about 42 feet to Adolphe Fragier's corner; thence with his line S. 77 W. 139 feet, more or less, to stake; thence N. 13 E. 39 feet, more or less to Lula Thompson's corner; thence with her line S. 77 E. 150 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner; being the same lot conveyed to me by Thos. Charles by deed dated June 21, 1913 and recorded in Book 20, page 121.

(2) That lot of land in the City of Greenville, said County and State, on Maully Street (formerly Vulcan Street) known as lot no. 3 of the parcel conveyed to C. H. Crosskeys by Mary S. Croft as described in the deed recorded in Book G. G. G. page 401, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake on Maully Street 95 feet from the corner of Maully and Ann Streets, and running thence N. 12-30 W. 50 feet with Maully Street to a stake; thence S. 77-30 W. 146 feet to a stake; thence S. 12-30 E. 50 feet to a stake; thence N. 77-30 E. 146 feet to the beginning; being the same lot conveyed to me by Wm. Goldsmith on the 23rd day of October, 1919.
