and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid; interest to be computed and paid semi-annually, have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent of the whole amount due, for attorney's fees, if said note be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being hereunto had as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN That I, David L. Norris, the said

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me

in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Ward Four, City of Greenville, on the south side of

East McBee Avenue, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at the Southwest corner of McBee Avenue and Falls Street, and running thence with McBee Avenue North 70-20 West two hundred-ten (210) feet four (4) inches to a point on McBee Avenue at corner of lot A; thence along the line of lots A and B, and with the outside edge of laundry wall, South 20-00 West one hundred one (101) feet, ten and one-half (10-1/2) inches; thence North 69-57 West twenty-two (22) feet, ten (10) inches to corner of Davenport's lot; thence South 20-57 West forty-eight (48) feet, six (6) inches to an iron pin on an alley; thence along said alley South 69-57 East two hundred thirty-four (234) feet, seven (7) inches to an iron pin at the intersection of said alley and Falls Street; thence with Falls Street North 19-45 East one hundred fifty-one (151) feet, eleven (11) inches to the beginning corner, being known as lot C of the Sue Harris Earle property, according to plat made by R.E.
