in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Joseph E. Earle and India Earle

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

beginning on the north side of said road, the southeast corner of said road, thence with said road S. 84.15 E. 353 ft. thence continuing with said road N. 29.13 E. 400 ft. to the beginning corner and containing 6.18 acres, more or less, said tract of land is situated about three miles from Greenville County on the north side of Pendleton Road and Southern Railway, a plot of which was made by R. E. Dalton April 1919.
