SEND GREETING:

with interest thereon from date at the rate of seven per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, on said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which are secured upon this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
obtain, sell and release unto the said J. W. Norwood, as Trustee and Individually

All that piece parcel and tract of land, situate
lying and being in the County and State aforesaid
on McBlanahan Mill Creek, waters of South
Saluda River, containing two hundred and fifty
five (255) acres, more or less, being the same tract
of land conveyed to G. A. Norwood, deceased, by
D. P. Verner, Master, by his deed bearing date
Oct. 3rd. 1895, and after the death of the said
G. A. Norwood conveyed to me both as Trustee
and individually by all the heirs at law of
the said G. A. Norwood, which said deed is
recorded in the office of Register of Deeds
Conveyance for the County and State aforesaid,
