kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me

in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and

released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Mattie F. Miller*

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in *Grove*

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina

*On waters of Grove Creek and Saluda River; Beginning at a dogwood 3X running thence S. 85° up 8.50 to a stone 3X, thence N. 9° E. 19.50 to a stone 3X thence S. 65° W. 12.50 to a stone 3X, thence S. 24° W. 13.58 to the beginning corner dogwood 3X. Being the same land conveyed to me by Daniel R. White on or about September 26, 1890. Said land containing sixteen and 7/10 (16-7/10) acres more or less. See Plat Book C. page 174.*
