all those certain tracts or parcels of land conveyed to me by Addie Black 12th Dec. 1919, containing Eighty acres more or less, recorded in Vol. 56 page 329 and three acres more or less, conveyed to me by A. M. Tanner Dec. 12th, 1919, recorded in Vol. 54 page 246 Greenville County South Carolina. All of which is situated in Chick Springs Township about two miles from Taylors Station on National Highway, on Mountain Creek, and bounded by lands now or formerly of H. M. Barton, W. B. Lock, Joseph Edwards et al.
