his heirs and assigns, All of that lot of land situate on the southwest side of Buncombe Road, near the City of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid and described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of Buncombe Road and Donnybrook Street, and runs thence along said Street S. 32-20 W. 187 feet to a fifteen foot alley; thence along said alley S. 53-27 E. 73.5 feet; thence N. 32-30 E. 187 feet to the Buncombe Road; thence along said road N. 58-27 W. 74 ft. to the beginning corner, being known as lot No. One as shown by plat recorded in Plat Book E., page 95 and the same land conveyed to me by the said Jos.
