of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, and the further providing for an attorney's fees

fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars, besides all costs and charges of collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind or
had, will more fully appear

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN That I, the said mortgagor,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better
securing the payment thereof to the mortgagee hereinabove named according to the terms of the said
note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me the said mortgagor
in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee

at and before the signing of these
Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Silas White, ALL my undivided one-third (1/3) interest in and to the following described
tract of land: "All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land containing three-fourths
(3/4) of an acre, more or less, situate and being in Grove Township, in the State and
County aforesaid, lying on the Piedmont Road near the Town of Piedmont: bounded by lands
of Wm. J. Payne, Piedmont Mfg. Co. and others.

Beginning on a stone corner on the aforesaid road; thence N. 5 E. 4.30 to a stone X3; thence
N. 76-3/4 W. 0.70 to a stone X3; thence S. 34-2 W. 4.10 to the said road stone X3; thence
S. 69 E. 2.90 to the beginning corner, and being the same tract of land conveyed to Thomas-
Frazier by John Frazier by deed dated June 12, 1899, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for
