Dollars, to be paid as follows: Thirteen Hundred and Seventy-five (1375.00) Dollars December 20th 1920 and Thirteen Hundred and Seventy-five (1375.00) Dollars December 20th 1921.

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that certain piece parcel or lot of land, situated, lying and being in the county and state aforesaid, on the N. E. side of Augusta Street, in the city of Greenville, known and designated as the eastern half of lot no. 1, as shown on plat of property of Parrish and Gower, North R. E. Dalton, Engineer dated May, 1919 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book E. page 156 and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the N. E. side of Augusta Street 236.8 feet from the intersection of Augusta Street and Diphentis Avenue, joint corner lots nos. 1 and 2, and running thence with the E. side of lot no. 2, N. 42-07 E. 147.6 feet to an iron pin on a 15 foot alley; thence with said alley N. 53-03 W. 62.2 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of the eastern and western half of lot (no. 1); thence with the western half of lot no. 1, in a southwesterly direction approximately 143 feet to an iron pin on Augusta Street; thence with Augusta Street S. 47-53 E. 68.75 feet to the point of beginning.
