until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to be added to the principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

A one-half (1/2) undivided interest, of in and to that certain lot or parcel of land situate in the Town of Greer, in the County and State aforesaid, at the north West corner of Hill Street and Mosteller Street, measuring on Hill Street, 110 feet, more or less, and on Mosteller Street 135 feet, more or less, on which lot is situate four brick stores and one wooden store; said lot being bounded as follows: On the north by lands of the Estate of L. J. Green, deceased; on the East by lands of M. B. Cunningham; on the south by Hill Street, and on the west by Mosteller Street, said lot being part of the lands of the estate of H. P. Moore, deceased, and which was conveyed to the said H. P. Moore by W. L. Hill, J. L. Green, Austin Green, et al.
