with interest from Date at the rate of eight per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid annually and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being hereunto had with more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN that the said Will Fields in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said H. K. Jones, all my right, title and interest in and to all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

Situate, lying and being on Anderson road about a mile and one-half from Greenville Court House containing 2.91 acres, more or less, and bounded by Brushy Creek, G. & C. Railroad and Little Brushy Creek and Anderson Road, and being the James Fields' property.

I hereby assigne all my interest in the proceeds of the sale made by the master and authorize said H. K. Jones to collect the same and after applying same to this debt to pay over to me the balance.
