NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I Ed Rosemond the said in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bank of Conestee

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina containing 4.8 acres, more or less, conveyed to me by John and Willie Walker by deed dated January 6, 1908, recorded in Book WWW, page 347. Also that other tract in the Township, County and State aforesaid, containing 9-1/2 acres, more or less, on the south side of White Horse Road, conveyed to me by Warren-Rosemond, deed dated March 21, 1898, recorded in Book EEE, page 738. Also that other tract of land in the Township, County and State aforesaid, containing 17 acres, more or less, known as lot No. 4 of the Sanford Macheam tract, conveyed to me by L.W. Parker and Frank Hammond, deed dated January 11, 1893, recorded in Book BBB, page 475. Also that other tract in the Township, County and State aforesaid on the White Horse Road containing 9 acres, more or less, conveyed to me by Warren and David Rosemond, by deed dated May 31, 1889, recorded in book CCC, page 651.
