all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

just outside the City limits of the City of Greenville
on the South side of Mills Avenue, being part of lots
5 and 7 of Block 7 of the subdivision of the estate of
O. P. Mills deceased, as shown on plat of same
recorded in office of R. M. C. for Greenville County
in plat Book 69 page 176: Beginning at a pin on the
South side of Mills Avenue corner of lot of J. H.
Simpson, said pin being 51 feet west of the corner of
lot no. 3; thence with line of Simpson S. 44-33 E. 8
180 feet to an alley; thence with said alley S. 45-27
W. 51 feet to stake; thence N. 44-33 W. 180 feet to pin
on Mills Avenue; thence with Mills Avenue N. 45-
27 E. 51 feet to the beginning.
