near Rocky Creek Baptist Church, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin in cross roads, and running thence S. 47 E. 16.58 chains to a white-oak 3xm; thence S. 41 E. 30.00 chains to a stake on Rocky Creek; thence up said creek following the meanders thereof as a line about 17.60 chs. to a stake on corner of land of Creight Jones; thence N. 24-1/2 W. 47.90 chs. to a stake, near a black gum; thence S. 76-1/2 W. 3.83 chs. to a stone on road; thence N. 47-1/2 E. 5.55 chs. to the beginning corner, and containing 47-1/2 acres, more or less; this being the same land conveyed to me by J.E.
