Dollars, to be paid Payable six (6) months after date

with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually in advance

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being partly within and partly without the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid on the north side of Prentiss Avenue, and being known and designated as Lot 7 of Block D. of O.P. Mills property as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book C., page 176, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Prentiss Avenue, corner of lot 6 and running thence with line of Lot 6, N. 44-33 W. 135 feet to rear line of lot 2; thence with rear line of lot 2, N. 45-27 E. 126 ft. to iron pin on line of lot 1 (L.A. Mills' property) thence with his line S. 22-18 E. 93.8 ft. to iron pin, corner of lot 8; thence with line of lot 8, S. 44-33 E. 48.2 ft to Prentiss Avenue; thence with Prentiss Avenue S. 45-27 W. 90.5 feet to the beginning corner.
