All that certain lot or parcel of land in the State and County
aforsaid, near the Judson Mills, and just off the Anderson
Road about two miles southwest of the Greenville County
Court House, described as follows: Beginning at an iron
pin distant 108 feet from street (extension of 8th Street from
Judson Mills Village to Old Anderson road) and joint corner
of McGaha and Judson Mills property, on an 8 foot alley
