until paid in full; an interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10 per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to

Beginning at an iron pin on Hubert street
L. H. Littlefield's corner and running thence with said

or iron pin on J. P. Parris' line; thence with said J. P.
Parris' line one hundred (100) feet to an iron pin on the
