I, Gertrude Robison, of the County and State aforesaid SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, Gertrude Robison  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

Thomas Harrison  
in the full and just sum of Eight thousand (\$8000.00)

Dollars, to be paid one year after the date thereof

with interest thereon from the date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue  
thereon and foreclose this mortgage and said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent of the amount due thereon besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had as will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Gertrude Robison

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

Thomas Harrison

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

Gertrude Robison

in hand well and truly paid by the said

Thomas Harrison

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,

bargain, sell and release unto the said Thomas Harrison, and his heirs and assigns forever, all that  
certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville,  
County and State aforesaid, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:  
Beginning at an iron pin on Southwest corner of Washington and Mordecai Streets, running  
thence with said Washington Street N. 71-1/2 W. sixty (60) feet to an iron pin; thence S.  
18-1/2 W. one hundred and seventy-six (176) feet, more or less to lot now owned by Witherspoon;  
thence with Witherspoon's line S. 70 E. fifty-nine (59) feet to iron pin on Mordecai Street;  
thence with said Mordecai Street N. 18-1/2 E. one hundred and seventy six (176) feet and one  
inch to the beginning corner, said above described lot being a part of the land bought  
by J.T., J.D. and R.I. Woodside from Alexander Finlay, Oct. 17th, 1905, deed recorded in R.M.C.  
Office for Greenville County in Vol. VVV at page 288, the said above lot being bounded on the  
north by Washington Street; on the East by Mordecai Street; on the South by lands of Wither-  
spoon, and on the West by lands of said Woodsides.  
The said lot having been conveyed to E.S. Griffin by said Woodsides by their deed of  
conveyance bearing date Feb. 15, 1910 and recorded in said R.M.C. Office in Vol. PPP, at  
page 254, and by said E.S. Griffin to Thomas Harrison by deed bearing date Dec. 29, 1911,  
recorded in said R.M.C. Office in Vol. 17, page 138. Said Thomas Harrison conveyed said lot  
to me Dec. 27, 1912; this mortgage being given to secure the balance of the purchase money  
of the same.
