Dollars, to be paid \$100.00 monthly on the first day of each  
Month beginning May 1st 1921 and monthly there-

with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid semi-annually in advance

until paid in full; and interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue  
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, and take further providing for an attorney's fee in addition to the amount due on said note, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all or which are secured under this mortgage as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

bargain, sell and release unto the said Fannie C. Norwood,

All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land,  
situate, lying and being in the State of  
South Carolina and County of Greenville, in  
the North ward of the city of Greenville, on  
the South side of East McFee Avenue; being  
the same lot of land conveyed to me by  
the said Fannie C. Norwood by deed dated  
April 2, 1921 not yet recorded; and more fully  
described as follows:

Beginning at a stake on the South side  
of East McFee Avenue, the northwest corner  
of a lot conveyed by Fannie C. Norwood to  
Hattie H. Shackelford by deed dated April 2, 1921;  
thence Southward along the line of the  
said Hattie H. Shackelford's lot 151 feet to a  
stake; thence Westward in a line parallel to  
and 151 feet from the line of McFee Avenue  
66 feet to a stake; thence Northward with  
the line of McFee Avenue 66 feet to the beginning  
corner.
