containing 26 9/10 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at a black jack on Rutherford Road, corner of Elrenga S. Cole (now Howard) tract, and running thence N. 84 E. 21-00 to stake; thence N. 80 E. 10-80 to point on Mrs. Nora Green's line; thence with Mrs. Green's line N. 78 1/2 W. 22-24 to stake on Rutherford road; thence along the middle of said road 16-64 to the beginning corner.
