all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in *Greenville*

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

Being a part of the lands of said Riverside Land Company, said lot being known and designated on a plat of said lands made by Carter and Pingle, Surveyors (which plat he recorded in said office) as lot no. 18 of Block 21 fronting 50 feet on Highland Road having a depth of 125 feet to the rear. Said plat is recorded in Plat Book A page 323.
