all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

City of Greenville, Ward Two, beginning at a stake on the Southeast corner of Williams and Pettigree Streets, thence north 64.56 east 63 feet with the south side of Pettigree Street to a stake corner of lot no. Two thence with the line of lot no. two south 20-35 east 138.14 feet to a stake in the north line of a ten-foot alley; thence with the north line of the alley south 64.56 west 177 feet to a stake in Williams Street, thence with Williams Street north 14-54 west 140 feet to the beginning corner, known as Lot no. one on a part of the property of Thomas F. Carter surveyed February 1916 and revised April 1919 by W. E. Hatten, Engineer.
