Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

On the east side of Duncan Street, having the following courses and distances according to plat made by Fitzpatrick Perry Co Engineers December, 1919, beginning at an old hub on the east side of Duncan Street, corner of Mrs. B. G. Wells, and running thence with her line S. 58-10 E. 77.25 to old hub, corner of Jennie C. Stow; thence with my line, and line of Miss Carrie Goodwin S. 48-55 E. 94.8 feet to iron pin; thence N. 32-42 E. 73 feet to iron pin in line of Mrs. Hattie M. Whitmore; thence with Latimer line N. 48-40 W. 78.67 feet to iron pin, corner of lot of Latimer and a ten foot alley; thence with line of said alley N. 55-09 W. 67 feet to iron pin; thence N. 61-08 W. 35 feet to iron pin on Duncan Street and thence with Duncan Street S. 25-56 W. 73 feet to the beginning corner. Being a portion of the lot of land conveyed to Mary J. Latimer by J. H. Latimer, deed dated May 10, 1875 and recorded in BPs, page 650 and devised by the said Mary J. Latimer.
