Alexander in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Peoples National Bank, as Executor of the Estate of D.D. Deavenport, deceased

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Fairview Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 75.19 acres, more or less, being what remains of a tract conveyed to T.M. Alexander by D.L. Bramlett, which originally contained 153 acres, after the conveyance by T.M. Alexander to Conestee Mills of 15.41 acres (see Deed Book 20, page 34) and the conveyance by T.M. Alexander to Edw. Henrix of 3.4 acres (see Deed Book 62, page 41) said tract of land is situate on the Log Road, about three miles South of Conestee Mills.
