to be paid on or before the date when the 6th, Series of the Capital Stock of the said AMERICAN GREENVILLE  
BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION shall reach maturity, with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly on or before  
Saturday night of each and every week until paid in full; and if I fail to pay said interest or  
to comply in all respects with the Constitution and By-Laws of said Association, for the space of thirty days, then said debt shall become immediately due and payable,  
together with all interest, fines and expenses, and all amounts advanced by the said Association on the within described property, by way of taxes or insurance, the

of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this  
mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being hereunto had, will more fully appear.

ASSOCIATION, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me

in hand well and truly paid by the said AMERICAN GREENVILLE BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is  
hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said AMERICAN GREENVILLE BUILDING  
AND LOAN ASSOCIATION All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the County

and State aforesaid, near the City of Greenville, in the subdivision known as "Kanatenah"  
and situated on the North side of Oregon Street, and known as lot #4 of Block C, on  
plat of the said property recorded in R.M.C. Office for said County in Plat Book F,  
at pp., 66 - 67.

The said lot has the following metes and bounds: beginning at a stake on the north side  
of Oregon Street, at corner of lot #3 in said block heretofore sold to C.E. Seawright,  
and running thence along Oregon St., N. 63-30 E. sixty feet to stake at corner of lot  
#5, heretofore sold to W.H. Hanckel; thence along said lot N. 26-30 W. one hundred and  
sixty-five feet to a stake, corner of lot #13; thence along said lot, S. 63-30 W. sixty
