WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Twenty Five Hundred

Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly,

the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin 240 feet East of the intersection of Choice Street and Oakland Avenue, and run thence with Choice Street S. 62. 19 E. 60 feet to an iron pin corner of lot 36; thence with line of that lot S. 34.50 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 62. 19 W. 60 feet to lot 34; thence with line of that lot N. 34.50 E. 150 feet to the beginning corner, being known as lot no. 35 of Oakland Heights as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book C page 147, and being the same land conveyed to me by M. W. Campbell, by deed dated the 7th day of April 1919, and recorded in Vol. 50, page 282.
