Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly,

the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure,

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, aliened, quitclaimed, conveyed and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about 2 1/2 miles from Greenville Court house, near the Easley Bridge Road, known as Lot No. 12 on plat of property of N.H. Harris, recorded in Plat Book E., page 208 and having the following metes and bounds, according to said plat: Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of Florida Avenue, corner of lot No. 10 (which pin is 440 feet S. 22-10 E. from the intersection of Florida Avenue and the Easley Bridge Road), and running thence with line of lot No. 10, N. 71 E. 151.09 ft. to iron pin, joint corner lots Nos. 10, 11, 12 and 13; thence with line of lot No. 13, in a southerly direction 80 feet to an iron pin, joint corner lots Nos. 12, 13, 14 and 15; thence with line of lot No. 14, S. 71 W. 142.19 feet to an iron pin on Florida Avenue, and thence with Florida Avenue N. 22-10 W. 80 feet to beginning corner.
