WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of One thousand (1000)

money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about 2-1/2 miles west of Greenville Courthouse, near the Easley Bridge Road, known as Lot 13 on plat of property of N.H. Harris, recorded in R.M.C. Office Greenville County in Plat Book E., page 208 and having the following metes and bounds, according to said plat:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Georgia Avenue, corner of lot No. 15 (which pin is 80.98 feet north of the intersection of Peachtree Street and Georgia Avenue) and running thence with Georgia Avenue N. 9-30 W. 80.98 feet to iron pin, corner of lot No. 11; thence with line of lot No. 11, in a westerly direction 151.09 feet to iron pin, joint corner of lots Nos. 10, 11, 12 and 13; thence with line of lot No. 12, in a southerly direction 80 feet to iron pin, joint corner of lots Nos. 12, 13, 14 and 15; and thence with line of lot No. 15, in a easterly direction 142.19 feet to the beginning corner.
