THIS INDENTURE, made this 3rd, day of October A. D. 1922

by and between C.P. McIntire

party of the first part, and the MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, of Greenville, S. C., a corporation, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Two thousand

Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly,

the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

All that portion of lot No. 7, being a lot of land situate at the Northwest corner of the Easley Bridge Road and Carolina Avenue in the sub-division of the Harris Land, known as "Highland", a plat of same being recorded in Plat Book C., page 146, beginning at the intersection of said road and Avenue and runs thence along said Avenue approximately N. 15.10 W. 50 feet; thence in a straight line parallel with the Easley Bridge Road to the rear line of lot No. 7, which line is the line of the right of way of the P. & N. Railway and being at a point 163 feet, more or less, from Carolina Avenue; thence along said right of way in a southwestern direction 50 feet to the Easley Bridge Road; thence along said road 158.4 feet to beginning, being as aforesaid a greater portion of lot No. 7.
