We, Hattie R. Holloway and Bronetta S. Holloway of Greenville, S.C. SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, WE, the said Hattie R. Holloway and Bronetta S. Holloway  
in and by OUR certain promissory note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, are yes and truly indebted to

D.W. Cochran, Jr., and E. Godfrey Webster  
in the full and just sum of Four hundred twenty-five  
Dollars, to be paid one year after date

with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid semi-annually

until full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

fifty dollars besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That WE the said Hattie R. Holloway and Bronetta S. Holloway  
for and in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

D.W. Cochran, Jr., and E. Godfrey Webster  
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to US, the said

Hattie R. Holloway and Bronetta S. Holloway  
in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagees

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said D.W. Cochran Jr., and E. Godfrey Webster, All these two

lots, pieces and parcels of land in the City of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid  
having the following lines and boundaries:

All that lot beginning at a stake on the west side of Calhoun St., 43 feet from an iron  
pin at the southwest corner of Calhoun and Dunbar Sts., and running southerly along Calhoun  
St. 43 feet to a stake; thence in a westerly direction in a line parallel to Dunbar St., 70  
feet to a stake at the rear corner of the lot hereinbelow described; thence in a northerly  
direction in a line parallel to Calhoun St., 43 feet to a stake; thence in an easterly  
direction parallel to the line of Dunbar Street 70 feet to the beginning corner.

All that lot: Beginning at a stake on the south side of Dunbar St., 70 feet from the  
southwest corner of Calhoun and Dunbar Sts., and running westerly thirty feet to a stake;  
thence southerly in a line parallel to Calhoun St., 83 feet to a stake in the rear; thence  
in an easterly direction 30 feet to stake at corner of lot above described; thence in a  
northerly direction parallel to line of Calhoun Street, 83 feet to beginning corner.
