and State aforesaid, being known and designated as Lot No. 2 on plat of the property of
Mrs. E. J. Whilden and Miss Ella Mauldin, which is recorded in the Register of Mesne
Conveyance for Greenville County in Plat Book E., at page 171, described as follows:-
Beginning at a point on Perry Avenue, fifty (50) feet distant from the intersection of
