I, J.E. Israel and Blanche L. Israel SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, We, the said J.E. Esrael and Blanche L. Israel  
in and by A certain collateral note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, are well and truly indebted to

H.P. Morrow and Mary Morrow  
in the full and just sum of Seven hundred  
Dollars, to be paid three hundred dollars annually until paid

with interest thereon from date being October 11th, 1921. at the rate of 6% per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee, of

ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage) and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That We the said J.E. Israel and Blanche L. Israel  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to US, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said

J.E. Israel and Blanche L. Israel -  
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said H.P. Morrow and Mary Morrow, All that tract or parcel of

land situated and lying and being about three miles Southwest of Greenville County Court-  
House and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:  
Beginning at a stake in the Center of the white Horse Road N. 6-15 W. 202 feet to a stake  
thence S. 81-20 W. crossing a branch and following same 200 feet to a point in the branch;  
thence continuing with the said branch as follows S. 89-10 W. 100 feet to a bend S. 79-0 W.  
71.8 feet to a bend S. 22-15 W. 55.3 feet to a point in the center of the bridge on the  
Public Road. Thence with line of W.T. Looper's property south 3-16 E. 151.8 feet to a stake  
in the center of an old road; thence along the said old Road N. 77-50 E. 169.4 feet to a  
bend; thence with the said old road and a public road N. 87-11 E. 236.2 feet to the point  
of beginning and containing 1.74 acres, more or less according to survey of R.E. Dalton,  
Engineer dated August 1921, and is a part of the same land conveyed to us by Louise Earle
