I, C.H. Huffling SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, C.H. Huffling, the said C.H. Huffling
in and by H.P. McGee certain Promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to
H.P. McGee

in the full and just sum of Three thousand and twenty-four and no/100
Dollars, to be paid \$30.00 Dec. 1st, 1921 and \$30.00 on the 1st, day of each succeeding month
thereafter until the 1st, day of Dec. 1922 when the whole amount becomes due and payable
immediately.

with interest thereon from December 1st, 1921 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of
ten per cent of amount due besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, C.H. Huffling, the said C.H. Huffling
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said H.P. McGee, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Green-

ville Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known and
designated as lot number 14, in a subdivision known as South Cherokee Park, S. Said lot
has a frontage on Keowee Avenue of Sixty feet and runs back to an alley to a depth of
one hundred seventy-two feet, for a more particular description reference to plat of said
sub-division is hereby craved. Said plat being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for
Greenville County in Plat Book A., page 130.

Also, all that other piece, parcel or lot of land in the aforesaid County and State and
being known as lot No. 15 in a subdivision known as South Cherokee Park. Said lot has a
frontage of sixty (60) feet on Keowee Avenue and runs back to an alley a depth on one
hundred and seventy two (172) feet. For a more particular description reference to plat
thereof is hereby craved. Said plat being recorded in the R.M.C. Office of Greenville
County in Plat Book A., page 130.

Also, all that other piece, parcel or lot of land in the aforesaid County and State and
known as lot No. 8 in a subdivision known as South Cherokee Park as shown by plat of said
property recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, at page 130.
Said lot fronts sixty feet on Grove Road and runs back one hundred and seventy two feet
to an alley.

The two lots first above described are those same lots conveyed to W.L. Mimms by L.O.-
Patterson, Trustee by deed recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book
58, at page 301. The last described lot is that lot of land conveyed to W.L. Mimms by
W.S. Clark by deed recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 64,
at page 154.

The three lots herein conveyed are those same lots conveyed to me this day 24th, of
September 1921 by W.L. Mimms.
